

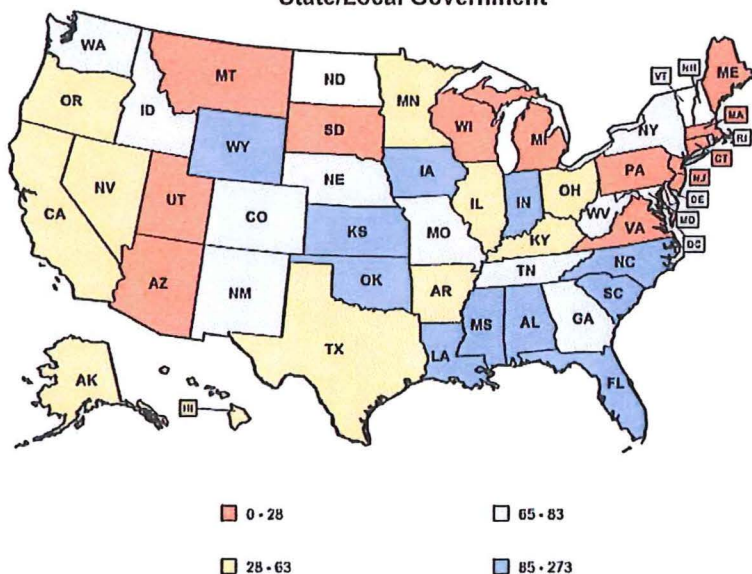
Hospital Emergency Room Visits per 1,000 Population by Ownership Type, 2010
